§ 2 1.	Representatives of organisations for snow sports from various countries unite in a spirit of friendship and fellowship in order to jointly promote, coordinate and develop all international matters relevant to snow sports in general and the instruction of snow sports in particular.	Representatives of organisations for snow sports (such as skiing, snowboarding etc. hereafter called snow sports) from various countries unite in a spirit of friendship and fellowship in order to jointly promote, coordinate and further develop all matters relevant to the instruction of snow sports.
§ 3 Addition	- coordinating a meeting of its members at least every two years, and staging an Interski Congress at least every four years;	
§4 1b)	[Ordinary members are] national organisations of the member countries. Only one organisation of a member country can be an ordinary member of Interski. This organisation must have legal capacity and must include, among its tasks, the teaching of snow sports. In addition, the said organisation must be a member of at least one of the Specialised Associations of Interski International. Where the applicant country is already represented, by a national association, in one or more of the International Specialised Associations pursuant to § 5, the said national association must be a member of the applicant organisation. National specialised associations which are established at a later date must be accepted into the national Interski organisation.	[Ordinary members are] national organizations of the member countries. Only one organization of a member country can be an ordinary member of Interski. This organization must have legal capacity and must include, among its tasks, the teaching of snow sports. In addition, the said organization must take into account at the least all three Specialized Associations pursuant to § 5, should they exist in the country concerned, or represent their interests, should these Specialized Associations not exist in that country. Where the applicant country is already represented by a national association in one or more of the International Specialized Associations pursuant to § 5, the national association involved must also be a member of the applicant organization. The name of the ordinary member association should include the word "Interski" combined with the name of the respective country.

<p>\$ 7</p> <p>1.</p>	<p>Ordinary members have the right to submit proposals to Interski and to adequately safeguard their interests in accordance with their own by-laws.</p> <p>Ordinary members oblige themselves to accept the Statutes of Interski, to work together in the Association, and to strive to communicate and implement the results of common efforts in accordance with the resolutions made.</p> <p>Ordinary members have a seat in the General Assembly and, insofar as they have met their financial obligations to Interski (\$10), are entitled to vote.</p> <p>They have the duty to pay their membership fees punctually.</p> <p>In years where a General Assembly with elections is held, Interski International's accounts must reflect full payment of that year's membership fee at least 24 hours before the General Assembly is due to begin.</p>	<p>Ordinary members have the right to submit proposals to Interski and to adequately safeguard their interests in accordance with their own by-laws.</p> <p>Ordinary members oblige themselves to accept the by-laws of Interski, to work together in the Association, and to strive to turn the results of common efforts into practical reality in accordance with the resolutions made.</p> <p>Ordinary members have a seat in the General Assembly and, insofar as they have met their financial obligations to Interski (\$ 10), are entitled to vote.</p> <p>They have the duty to pay their dues punctually.</p>

<p>\$7</p> <p>4.</p>	<p>Members are obliged to pro-actively communicate any changes to their contact data to the General Secretariat, without being explicitly requested to do so.</p>	<p>Honorary members may participate in the Association's activities.</p>
<p>\$9</p> <p>2.</p>	<p>The General Assembly takes the final decision to expel ordinary members by a 2/3 majority of the valid votes cast.</p> <p>An ordinary member can appeal to the General Assembly against such a decision within two months after receiving the notice of expulsion.</p> <p>All rights and duties are suspended until the General Assembly makes its decision.</p>	<p>An ordinary member can appeal to the General Assembly against such a decision within two months after receiving the notice of expulsion.</p> <p>All rights and duties are suspended until the General Assembly makes its decision.</p>

\$12 6.k *	Elections of the President, the two Vice-Presidents (§ 13.1a - c) and the auditors (§ 16);	The elections of the president, the first and the second vice-president (§ 13, 1 a – c) and the auditors (§ 16);
\$12 8	The elections of the President, the two Vice-Presidents and the auditors are conducted according to the Rules of Procedure for Elections as decided by the General Assembly.	The elections of the president, the first and the second vice-president and the auditors are held according to the "Procedure for electing the president, the first and second vice-presidents and the auditors" adopted by the General Assembly.
\$13 b	the two Vice-Presidents,	the first vice-president, and the second vice-president.
\$13 e	the representative, with a seat and a vote, of the ordinary member that has been awarded the organisation of the next Interski Congress.	A representative of the ordinary member that has been awarded the organization of the next Interski congress (in an advisory capacity).
\$13 2.	The Presidium is elected for four years. Its term of office ends with the next elections. The Presidium is elected at the General Assembly held between two Interski Congresses. Re-election of the President and the two Vice-Presidents is allowed.	The Presidium is elected for four years. Its term of office runs until the next elections. Re-election of the president and the first and second vice-presidents is allowed. The Presidium meets as needed.
\$13 3.c	The Presidium holds physical meetings at least once a year. Other means of communication (such as Skype) should be employed. to coordinate the schedules of the international Specialised Associations and working committees, if necessary;	to coordinate the plans of operation of the international Specialised Associations and working committees if necessary.

\$13 3.h	to decide on the admissibility of bids to organise Interski Congresses, and to decide on the withdrawal of the Congress should an organiser fail to meet the obligations and deadlines stipulated in the Organiser's Contract in full.	To decide to withdraw the Congress and assign it to the most suitable applicant if an organiser cannot fully keep the obligations and deadlines stipulated in the organiser's contract;
\$13 5	The Presidium's activities are governed by the Rules of Procedure of the Presidium of Interski International.	The Presidium draws up its own internal rules of procedure.
\$13 11	If unable to attend a Presidium meeting, the President and the two Vice-Presidents cannot send a deputy to act on their behalf. The Presidents of the Specialised Associations can appoint a deputy, who must be nominated at the beginning of their term of office, to attend Presidium meetings in their stead.

<p>\$18</p> <p>1.</p>	<p>The General Assembly and the Presidium decide on motions by a simple majority of the valid votes cast unless otherwise provided for in the Statutes or the Rules of Procedure of the Presidium (§ 9, § 20, § 21).</p>	<p>The General Assembly and the Presidium decide motions by an absolute majority of the valid votes cast, insofar as the by-laws or the Rules of Procedure for the Presidium do not prescribe otherwise (§ 9, § 20, § 21).</p>
<p>\$18</p> <p>3.</p>	<p>Minutes reflecting all resolutions of General Assemblies, the Presidium and the working committees must be drawn up and sent out within 21 days. The minutes are approved at the next meeting of the same body.</p>	<p>Minutes are to be kept of all resolutions of the General Assembly, the Presidium, and the working committees. They shall be signed by the person presiding over the meeting and by the recording secretary. The minutes are to be sent to all participants of the meeting, as well as to the Interski Secretariat; they are to be approved at the next meeting of the same body.</p>
